Apprentice Cabinet Makers (2 positions)

Under the direction of the **Cabinet Production Supervisor**, the **Apprentice Cabinetmaker** increases the efficiency of the millwork shop by assisting with cabinet and counter top fabrication. The incumbent will demonstrate skill in the manual use of a wide variety of small tools and specialized equipment. Work must be completed in a safe manner, of high quality, with the ability to respond to customer demand. All Cabinetmakers should possess teamwork and communication skills. The Apprentice Cabinetmaker will possess sufficient trade knowledge to exercise independent judgment on some decisions. While formal schooling will increase their knowledge of cabinet and countertop fabrication processes, the Apprentice will follow the instructions of management and supervisors in setting job priorities, honing trade skills, and applying safe work practices. In order to be fully aware of the hazards and safety requirements of the job, the Apprentice must learn the safety practices, policies, and procedures outlined in the *Health and Safety Handbook* and the *Orientation Handbook*. As a team, the Cabinetmakers will work together to meet tight deadlines for cabinet and countertop production.

- *Type of equipment used:* Router, pinch press, plastic laminate slitter, drum sander, various hand tools
- Record materials used before pulling from inventory
- Perform cuts on saws
- Assemble cabinets cut from the CNC Router
- Keep work area clean
- Report all safety concerns and/or incidents to a supervisor/manager.
- Interact daily with shop co-workers and office staff
- Responsible to observe all safety policies and procedures when in the workplace.

Working Conditions

- Primarily indoor, noisy environment, lifting & moving material up to 50 lb.
- General hazards associated with working in a wood working shop
- Supply your own CSA approved footwear
- Minimum work week is Monday to Thursday 7 am to 5 pm, Friday 7 am to noon; overtime is readily available
